


Suggestions for Printing Cards to Promote Clubs

This process has taken some fiddling. Buy business card sheets which have easy-tear perforations for 2 by 3.5 inch cards such as below. Put a sheet into a printer with the arrow into the printer.



Open the CardDesign pdf file or download it from <https://astroschoolclub.ca/CardDesign.pdf>. Open it and press print. Make sure the pdf program is set for “Actual size” and not “Fit to printing margins” (next to blue arrow). Ideally use a printer with tanks rather than cartridges.



Click the final print button. Then inspect the result to make sure the images fit the cards. If they don't, then check your settings. If that doesn't fix it, take the CardDesign file to a printer.

Take the printed sheet and turn it so the same end is entering the printer, but the other face is towards you. Print again so each sheet is printed on both sides.



The perforated card stock can be easily split into 10 cards by folding.



As an alternative, get them printed. The Staples website cost for 500 double sided cards is only a little more than 2 packages of sheets to make 250 each.

Hand them out at outreach events, but other local places like museums and shops selling telescopes and cameras might also carry them.
